**2010-2011 Registration Fees:**

**\$225 – Full Year (Fall & Spring)**

**\$125 – ½ Season (Fall OR Spring)**

Player registration fees will cover 16 games for a full year player (8 in Fall and 8 in Spring) and 8 games for a ½ season player. Additionally the registration fees cover two tournaments for a full year player and one tournament for a ½ season player. Travel costs are the responsibility of the player/parent.

Uniforms/Jackets/Bags/Apparel are not included in the registration fees. Uniforms are the only required extra cost.
